

What Is Bleu Doing To Provide A Safe Environment During COVID-19?

Our guidelines and procedures for studio cleaning and safe performing arts practices have expanded. Our primary goal is to provide a safe environment for our dance community!

Please know that we follow the mandates of The State of Virginia, and guidelines from the medical community including The Virginia Department of Health, The Loudoun County Department of Health, and The CDC.

- We've partnered with CINTAS Facility Services for electrostatic disinfecting services using EPA registered disinfectant solutions that include those for use against SARS-CoV-2, the cause of COVID-19.
- The studio will also receive cleaning with EPA registered disinfectant solutions throughout the day of surfaces including high touch areas.
- We are installing higher efficient HEPA air filters for our HVAC systems
- Touchless dispensers for hand soap and paper towels will be in all restrooms.
- Touchless hand sanitizer stations will be located in multiple areas of the studio for ease of use by faculty and students.
- Touchless thermometers have arrived and we will be utilizing them daily upon re-opening.
- We are busy preparing our hallways and classrooms for State of Virginia mandated social distancing with floor signage and directional signage.
- Informational signage, Phase 2 policies and signage to encourage healthy practices will be throughout the studio as well as on exterior and interior doors.
- We are training our faculty on cleaning protocols, positive enforcement of social distancing measures and best practices to prevent illness and encourage healthy in-studio habits for our students.
- When we return to in-person instruction with students during Phase 2 we will provide non-contact instruction.
- Our faculty will participate in a health checklist, be temperature checked and wear face masks during Phase 2.
